general **DIABETES EDUCATION**

If you have specific questions about your diabetes, you should contact your health care provider. Here are some local agencies that specialize in diabetes education for patients.

Living Smart With Diabetes is a 3-Part class which runs the 1st, 2nd, and 4th Monday of every month. The cost is covered by Medicare and most insurance.

Most insurance companies will cover this diabetes education course. The fee of \$640 for the standard group education course is covered by Medicare. Physician referral is needed.

The course includes 10 hours of education; the patient meets with a dietician, a nurse educator, and an exercise physiologist. Diabetic patients will learn how to use a glucose monitor, meal planning, exercise motivation, and medication management. The course is taught at Venice Regional Medical Center and costs \$760.00. Medicare and most insurance covers 80-100% of this cost. This course is certified by the American Diabetes Association.

Free diabetes lectures also take place at the HealthPark on the first Thrusday of every month at 1 p.m..

As part of the Amputation Prevention Program for Lower Extremities (APPLE), a nurse assesses the skin, capillaries, and circulation in the feet. The nurse also teaches the client how to properly wear shoes and what dangerous signs to look for regarding foot care. Medicare will pay 100% of the cost for therapeutic shoes which are fitted by a podiatrist or pedorthist. This nurse will contact your doctor and get the physician order for these shoes.
